TERM 2 UNIFORM REMINDER

Uniform:

When term 2 resumes, children may wear either full summer uniform/full winter uniform for the first two weeks of the term, up-to-and-including Friday 11 May. Thereafter, children are to please come to school in full winter uniform. For your winter uniform purchasing requirements, the Uniform Shop will be open on Thursday 26th April from 7am to 2pm. As a reminder, the winter uniform consists of the following:

Grades R-6:

Full regulation school tracksuit;

Long sleeve round neck green shirt;

Regulation green school jersey;

On PE days, children wear the required white/black takkies with their tracksuit;

On non-PE days, children wear their black school shoes with their tracksuit;

Extra's: bottle green beanie, scarf, gloves and regulation bomber jacket, all available from the school uniform shop.

Grade 7:

PE days:

Full regulation school tracksuit;

Long sleeve round neck green shirt;

Regulation green school jersey;

White/black takkies;

Optional extra's: bottle green beanie, scarf, gloves and regulation bomber jacket, all available from the school uniform shop.

On non-PE days:

Girls: bottle green skirt, long sleeve white button-up shirt, green tie, regulation green school jersey, flesh-coloured stockings (not black, white or green – but rather so that natural skin colour is shown) if desired and long green regulation socks and black school shoes.

Boys: bottle green long pants, long sleeve white button-up shirt, green tie, regulation green school jersey, long green regulation socks and black school shoes.
